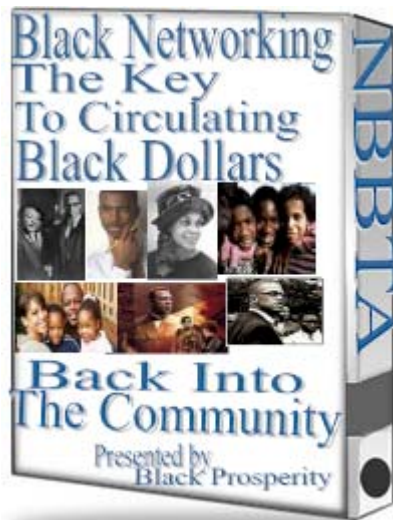


Black Networking: The Key to Circulating Black Dollars Back Into The Community



Networking: A supportive system of sharing information and services among individuals and groups having a common interest:

So what is networking and why is it so important?

A supportive system- many of us hear all the time Black People don't stick together, who are these black people? Is it you is it me? The bottom line is that if you and me stick together then we stick to another then another then we can create great things.

Tip: The next time you patronize a Black Owned business and you receive poor service then write them a letter don't curse them out, no one like a tongue lashing I don't do you. Any serious business owner would appreciate any customer comments help them to improve. Even if you decide not to go back, this may break the cycle of Blacks not supporting each other.

Individuals and groups who have a common interest: Ok let's look at this very last part individuals and groups who have a common interest. First of all it starts with an individual **you**, what ever your interests are, you are looking for others who have something in common with you. This is why it is so important who you associate yourself with this is the foundation of networking. At this level it can become negative or positive it all starts with the individual.

Next is, individuals that is you and another person who have a common interest then after that a group is created then other groups, but at this level it can become a little tricky sometimes after a while someone ego gets in the way and the common interest starts to break down.

When it get to this point you as an individual have to make a decision whether or not you are going to allow the group to break down or make suggestions so that the group may stay on track, or leave the group.

The funny part about being Black you can not hide from it, you can't change it, what you can change is how you live and how it can effect others, weather it is negative or positive.

If each one of us does our part then we can change the age-old saying:

From: "BLACK PEOPLE DON'T STICK TOGETHER"

**To: "BLACK PEOPLE DO STICK TOGETHER,

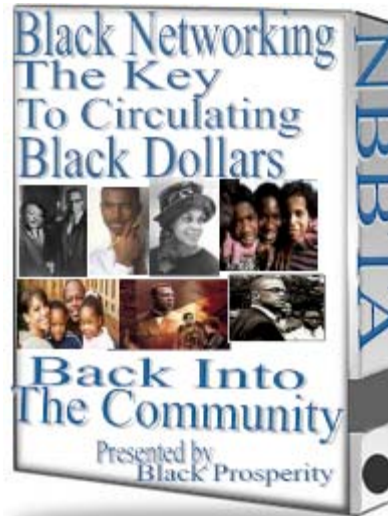
